With increasing use of dental implants, the incidence of complications with this treatment modality is increasing too; implant complications can be surgical, mechanical, biological, aesthetic and phonetic. The problems such as implant malposition, peri-implantitis, marginal bone loss, implant failure, implant fracture, abutment fracture, abutment screw loosening and fracture, prosthesis fracture; etc. caused with various situations. Before proceeding with replacement of the failed implant or refabricating the failed prosthesis, the practitioner should ask, "Why did such complication happen?"

Understanding and management of these complications are crucial for long-term prognosis of dental implant treatments. In this course, we review virtual cases of prosthetic complications to find out their causes, problems, solutions, and approaches for prevention.
